**FONOF** was conceived and developed by the design team at PORT Designs, which specialises in technical luggage.

The result is an ergonomic, robust and durable pouch that is perfectly suited to the realities of school life.

#### Total wave blocking

Thanks to its anti-RFID lining, FONOF neutralises all transmissions and receptions (calls, notifications, ringtones). Phones are completely isolated, guaranteeing an effective digital break.

#### Universal compatibility

FONOF safely accommodates smartphones up to 7 inches with their protective cases, covering all models used by secondary school pupils.



#### Practical and durable features

- Transparent pocket on the back: allows you to insert a badge or personalised card (photo, name, class), avoiding confusion between identical pouches. Students can easily recognise their pouch, and staff can carry out quick checks if necessary.
- White marking area: facilitates collective identification by number or name.
- Can be personalised: school or community logo to reinforce visual identity and sense of belonging.
- Recycled, water-repellent outer material: resistant to everyday use and environmentally responsible.
- 4-year guarantee: designed to last for a full secondary school cycle.



## Secure and quick magnetic closure

A magnetic closure system ensures reliable locking, with no sharp edges or risk of scratches. It is **simple**, **intuitive and quick to use**, allowing each student to secure their phone independently as soon as they arrive at school.

Each pouch can only be opened with an aluminium unlocking base. **Schools can deploy several bases**, fixed in strategic areas (hallway, exit, school life) or worn around the neck by authorised staff.


